## Treasurer's Report

The meeting noted the analyses that the Treasurer has provided on the cost of hiring premises, receipts from members' session fees and the downward trend in account balances.

The meeting also noted the Treasurer's views on the appropriate bank balance to be held as reserves. The meeting agreed that the subject of session fees, membership subscription and reserve funds should be covered at the next AGM. Also, the status and the management view on the way forward should be communicated to the membership, in advance of the AGM, in a magazine article.

## Report from MC

AS advised that instead of Sub-Committees sending all minutes and documents to MC meetings they had been asked to report directly at the meeting. Reports etc., could be sent if they were unavailable and this had proved better time usage at meetings. If Committee members required a copy of the F & R log then DF would send via e.mail.

Therefore it was suggested that we revert back to the combined Executive Committee profile merging the Management Committee with the Trustee Committee. Also the six year rule prohibiting

anyone from remaining a Trustee for a longer period may be looked into. MT to ask Ian Grant to look at the Constitution with a view to allowing this to happen and what constraints, if any, there may be.
